Infant Baptism: Parents, call the parish office to register for class held the 1st Monday of the month at 7:00 p.m. Please plan to attend the preparation before the birth of your child. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the 1st and 3rd Sundays of the month, following the 12:00 p.m. Mass.

Marriage Preparation: Please register with a priest for Pre-Cana at least 6 months prior to wedding.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the parish office to request this Sacrament and for home or hospital visitation. Anyone who is anticipating surgery is encouraged to request this sacrament prior to being admitted to the hospital.
